T.I.N.A - lightly carbonated tea infusion, Melbourne, VIC

An invigorating oolong infused with honey bush, lemon myrtle, rose, pear juice, calamansi, monk fruit juice and roast coriander. Made locally by Imogen and Chrissie from This Is Not Alcohol.

Lee Ho Fook House Blend Tea - White Peony, Jasmine Tea, Rose Petal

The Fujian classic white tea forms the base, lending the blend its savoury note which is counterbalanced by the fragrance of red rose petal and silver jasmine tea.

Supplementary \$8 per person

Silver Jasmine Tea - Oolong, Guangdong, China

Plenty of silver tips, this is a green tea that should be recognised not only for its jasmine infused scent, but the quality of the tea leaves themselves..

Iron Goddess - Oolong Tea, Fujian, China

This is a high altitude Oolong tea from Fujian. It is lightly oxidised before being rolled. The Iron Goddess has a signature floral scent of frangipani, osmanthus and honey.

Yunnan Red - Pu-Erh, Yunnan, China

Viscous mouthfeel paired gentle notes of vanilla, butterscotch and malt. Perfectly complementing anything savoury.

Red Mystic - Black Tea, Yunnan, China

Fully oxidised giving it a molasses and sweet malt flavour profile are complimented by earthy flavours.

Genmaicha - Green Tea with roasted rice, Kagoshima Ken, Japan

Well balanced. Nori and maritime notes blend with toasted muesli on the backdrop.

2022 Jim Barry 'The Florita', Riesling, Clare Valley, SA

The nose delivers to the palate, with intensified florals and citrus juice flavours and a long, concentrated finish.

2022 Stefano Lubiana, Pinot Gris, Derwent Valley, TAS

Brimming with pear, rose water, quince and Turkish fig flavours. Finishing with the perfect amount of astringency, complimenting the sensational fruit element, leaving a refreshed palate.

2023 Shadowfax Gewürztraminer, Macedon Ranges, VIC

Persimmon, lime and lychee fruits spill onto the palate. There is a fleshiness to the wine that is held taught by the pithy acid line. Spicy ginger phenolics focus the palate, helping add structure and drive. The finish is fresh and zesty

2021 Tournon 'Mathilda', Viognier, Marsanne, Heathcote, VIC

Fresh crisp and fruity nose with stone fruit in abundance. The palate supple and fresh, with great minerality and fruit weight.

2022 Antaeus, Grenache, Barossa Valley, SA

Prominent earthy nose, notes of red chalk, raspberry, lots of crunchy cherry, lovely build of tannin on the palate.

2016 Mac Forbes 'Hugh', Cabernet Sauvignon Blend, Yarra Valley, VIC

Fragrant, tobacco and gentleman's club lounge feel, redcurrant, strawberry, a bit of ripe tomato, cedar, vanilla and aniseed. Medium-bodied, light on its feet, juiciness to the fruit, supple tannin, a pleasing minty fragrance, clean acidity, and a fine length, a sweet orange tang in the aftertaste.

NV Chambers 'Old Vine', Muscadelle, Rutherglen, VIC

Deep tawny coffee colour with a hint of olive at the edge. Mocha and coffee bean aromas with toffee and malt with just a hint of cold tea, good length of flavour with persistence.
